

To disengage the working towers, the VERTICALE MIS Working Tower Removal Tool must be connected with the handle and then inserted into the MIS Working Tower. The working tower is disengaged from the pedicle screw head by turning anti-clockwise with slight downward pressure. The working tower is only fully disengaged from the screw and can be removed when the yellow marking on the working tower becomes visible (inset). In doing so, the VERTICALE MIS Counter Torque can be used to stabilise the rotation when disengaging the MIS Working Towers.




Removal of the VERTICALE MIS Working Towers using the VERTICALE MIS Working Tower Removal Tool
